“Though the reserve designation might suggest otherwise, this is a mid-tier wine, less expensive and with less new oak than the Nuthouse. Slightly reductive at first, there are traces of burnt rubber in the aromas, but aggressive aeration will fix that. The fruit is raspberry all the way, with a toasty finish from 16 months in one-quarter new French oak.” —Paul Gregutt
